

Current Working Grade

This shows the GCSE Grade at which a student is currently working.

For example:

4.2 means a student is working mostly at Grade 4 with some elements at Grade 3.

4.5 means a student is working solidly at Grade 4 in all key areas.

4.8 means a student is secure at all elements of Grade 4 and is starting to work at some elements of Grade 5.

On average, students progress at approximately 1 grade per year. However, this can vary significantly between subjects and for an individual within a subject. For example languages will start in Y7 at a lower starting point but would expect to progress at a quicker rate compared to other subjects.
